Rebekah with twin baby boys. Our next unit will be about Jacob and Esau.

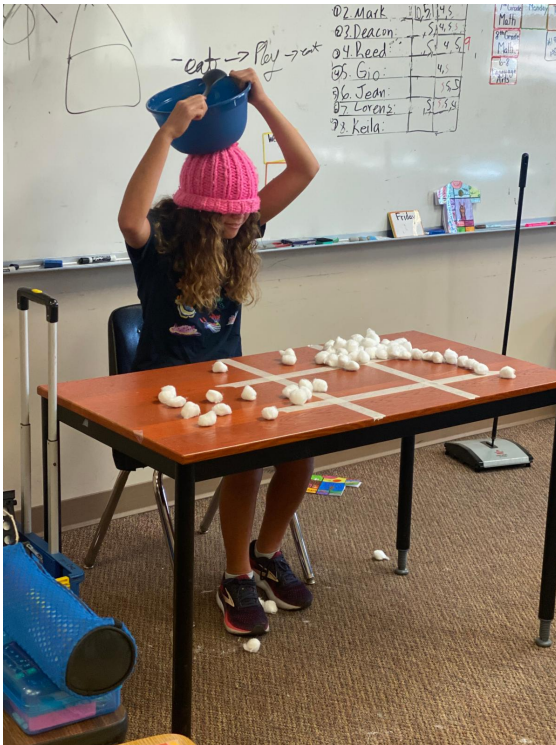

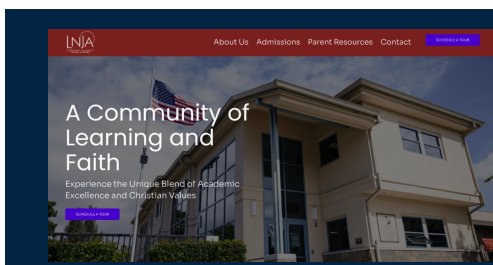
