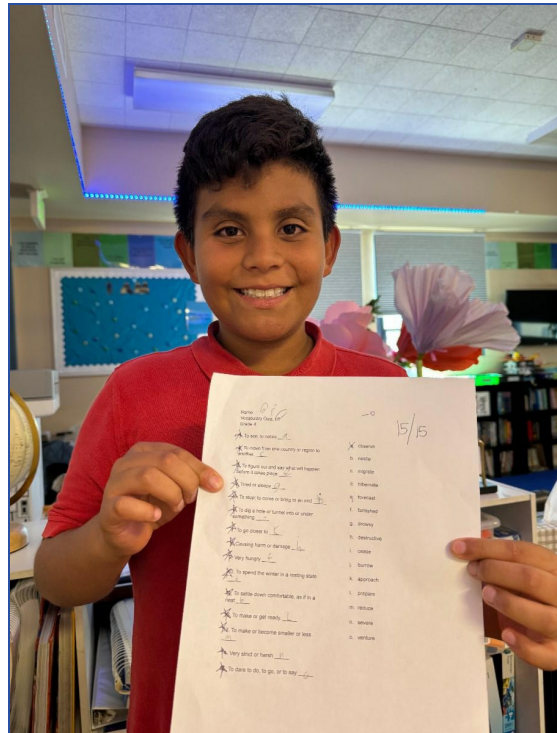
Classroom Highlights
